Ministers' Emergency Fund

In covenant with one another, clergy of the Louisiana Annual Conference are asked to contribute up to one-half of one percent of their base salary to the ministry of the Ministers' Emergency Fund (MEF). The money is used to help our fellow clergy when he/she is experiencing tough times and a financial hardship.

To contribute to this ministry, the clergy person indicates an amount on line 4 of the compensation form. To calculate the suggested one-half of one percent, you multiply the number listed at the top of Part 1 by .005.

The MEF amount on the **2020 Clergy Compensation Form** is an annual amount and is deducted prorated over each pay period from the payroll checks of the clergy person by the church and sent to the Annual Conference on their regular monthly statement (line 5030). At the discretion of the clergy person, this deduction can be done at one time. For example, if your base compensation is \$50,000 per year, then the suggested Ministers' Emergency Fund contribution would be \$250 per year, or \$20.83 per month.
